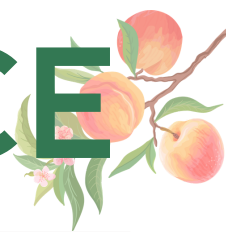

50/50 475.00 which was donated to a young boy who is very sick.

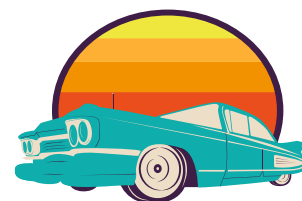
Food Pantry 300.00
